AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CHAGRIN VALLEY PAVING, INC. FOR THE RESURFACING OF US 6A RAMPS C & D AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$232,273.00 AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the resurfacing of US 6A Ramps C & D; and

WHEREAS, five (5) bids were received on February 22, 2021, as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached, copies of which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the engineering consultants from Mackay Engineering along with the Safety Service Director have evaluated the bids and recommend the lowest and best bid from Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc., be accepted in the amount of Two Hundred Thirty Two Thousand Two Hundred Seventy Three Dollars and 00/100 (\$232,273.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc., 17290 Munn Road, Chagrin Falls, OH 44023, for the resurfacing of US 6A Ramps C & D, in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Thirty Two Thousand Two Hundred Seventy Three Dollars and 00/100 (\$232,273.00) as further explained in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the cost of the resurfacing of US 6A Ramps C & D shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund-Capital Improvement Roads account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

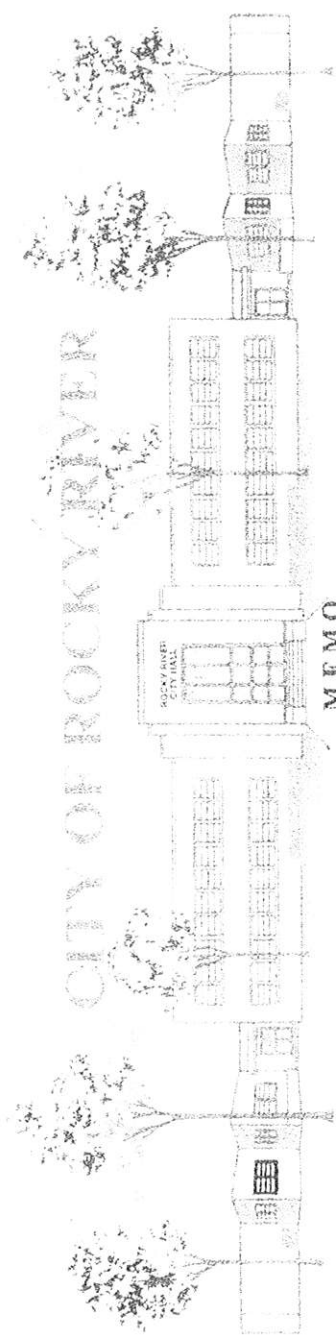

On each estimated quantity item the "TOTAL ITEM AMOUNT IN FIGURES" must equal "TOTAL UNIT PRICE IN FIGURES" multiplied by the "ESTIMATED QUANTITY". Discrepancies will be handled in accordance with the notes contained herein.

NOTES:

1. To complete "Bidders' Unofficial Total" and "Total Unit Price in Figures", on these items the estimated quantities and units by the estimated quantities and add to "Contingency Allowance" items and "Contingency Allowance" items. The total thus computed is for your convenience in comparing bids and will be used for that purpose only. Each bidder must submit prices for each and every item on the bid form, and failure to do so will render the bid irregular and subject to rejection.
2. The Proposal Guaranty amount (see Section 2.1.1) shall be based on the amount of "Bidders' Unofficial Total" (see Note 2) for calculation. The "Contingency Allowance" items shall be included in this total. The amount of the Contract Bond and Payment Bond shall be based on the total Contract Amount and the bidder shall distribute the cost of these bonds over all the basic and optional items.
3. If a mathematical error is found after the opening of the bids, the City will correct such errors by the following method:
 - a. "Unit Price in Figures for Material" and "Unit Price in Figures for Labor" will be assumed to be correct.
 - b. The "Unit Price in Figures for Material" and "Unit Price in Figures for Labor" will be calculated by summing the "Unit Price in Figures for Material" and the "Unit Price in Figures for Labor".
 - c. The calculated "Unit Price in Figures for Labor" will be multiplied by the quantity to determine the "Total Item Amount in Figures".
 - d. The "Bidders' Unofficial Total" will be calculated by summing the "Total Item Amount in Figures" for each bid item including the "Contingency Allowance".
 - e. The calculated "Bidders' Unofficial Total" will be used in determining the lowest and best bidder.
4. All items shall be bid. The City will determine the lowest and best bidder based on the total of the above bid items plus "Contingency Allowance" items and the "Contingency Allowance". The City expressly reserves the right to determine of work, including but not limited to entire streets or sections of streets or individual items of work, without objection and without effect on a contract or project for other items.
