AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO PURCHASE PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT FOR THE ROCKY RIVER PARK FROM GAMETIME AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$144,298.01, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Director of Recreation requested proposals for pricing for the purchase of new Playground Equipment for Rocky River Park; and

WHEREAS: three (3) proposals were vetted by the Parks and Recreation Commission, Parks and Recreation Foundation as well as the Recreation Department staff, copies of which is are file in the office of the Director of Recreation; and

WHEREAS: the Director of Recreation has determined it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to select the lowest and best bid for the Playground Equipment for Rocky River Park from GameTime, at a total cost not to exceed One Hundred Forty Four Thousand Two Hundred Ninety Eight Dollars and 01/100 (\$144,298.01), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River be and is hereby authorized to purchase Playground Equipment for Rocky River Park from GameTime, P.O. Box 208, Harrison, Ohio, 45030 at a cost not to exceed One Hundred Forty Four Thousand Two Hundred Ninety Eight Dollars and 01/100 (\$144,298.01), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That \$144,298.01 shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund Rocky River Park account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that it is necessary to replace playground equipment that is in disrepair and to minimize delay for delivery, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

RE: Rocky River Park Playground

Upon completing a thorough review of three vendor proposals related to the replacement of Rocky River Park Playground, I would recommend the project be awarded to GameTime at a competitive proposal of \$144,298.01 (\$105,701.99 under budget).

The attached GameTime ship design has been vetted by the Parks & Recreation Commission, Parks & Recreation Foundation as well as the Recreation Department Staff. Additionally, after a search of Finding for Recovery with the Ohio Auditor of State, the vendor record came back negative.

For reference, the three vendors considered included:

The project scope will include:

Removal of current structure and excavation of space completed by the City. Installation of new equipment, timber boarders and wood fibar to be completed by GameTime with an average lead time of between four and six weeks for standard items.
