AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO PURCHASE ONE (1) 75 CUBIC YARD REFUSE TRANSFER TRAILER FOR THE SERVICE DIVISION FROM REFUSE EQUIPMENT & TRUCK SERVICES, INC. AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$81,100.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety Service advertised bids for the purchase of one (1) 75 Cubic Yard Refuse Transfer Trailer for the City of Rocky River Service Division; and

WHEREAS: one (1) bid was received on November 27, 2020 for the 75 Cubic Yard Refuse Transfer Trailer, copy of which is on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety Service has determined it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to select the lowest and best bid for a 75 Cubic Yard Refuse Transfer Trailer from Refuse Equipment & Truck Services, Inc., at a total cost not to exceed Eighty One Thousand One Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$81,100.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

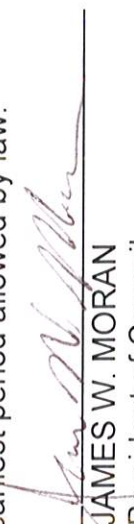
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River be and is hereby authorized to purchase one (1) 75 Cubic Yard Refuse Transfer Trailer from Refuse Equipment & Truck Services, Inc., 237 State Road, PO Box 1424, Ashtabula, OH 44005-1424 at a cost not to exceed Eighty One Thousand One Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$81,100.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That \$81,100.00 shall be paid from the Equipment Purchase Fund Refuse and Recycling Vehicles and Large Equipment account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that it is necessary to replace equipment that is in disrepair to minimize delay for delivery, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

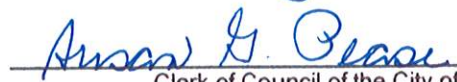

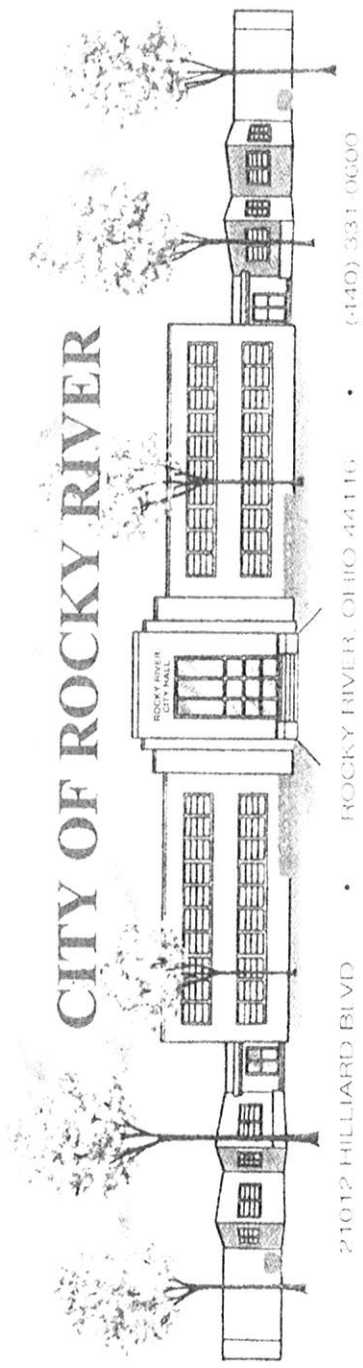

One bid proposal was opened on November 27, 2020 for one (1) 75 yard Semi-Trailer for Refuse from Refuse Equipment & Truck Services, Inc. They are the manufacturer who has built our previous two trailers. Our appropriated amount for this trailer is \$105,000 and the bid came in at \$81,100 which includes delivery. Their expected delivery time is 90-120 days from issuance of the purchase order.
