ORDINANCE NO. 40-21

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE AND INSTALL ONE (1) EMERGENCY GENERATOR FOR THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER CIVIC CENTER, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$216,919.00, AS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for proposals for the purchase of one (1) emergency generator for the City of Rocky River Civic Center; and

WHEREAS: Six (6) proposals were received for the emergency generator copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS: The Director of Public Safety Service has determined it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to purchase this emergency generator from the lowest and best proposal submitted by Zenith Systems, LLC., at a cost not to exceed Two Hundred Sixteen Thousand Nine Hundred Nineteen Dollars and 00/100 (\$216,919.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to purchase one (1) emergency generator at a cost not to exceed Two Hundred Sixteen Thousand Nine Hundred Nineteen Dollars and 00/100 (\$216,919.00), from Zenith Systems, LLC., 5055 Corbin Drive, Bedford Heights, OH 44128 as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That a NOPEC Powering our Communities Grant has been awarded for this generator; said funding to be forwarded to the City of Rocky River.

SECTION 3. That this emergency generator shall be paid for from the Capital Improvement Fund—Capital Improvement Buildings Account.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and to preserve pricing, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor: otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

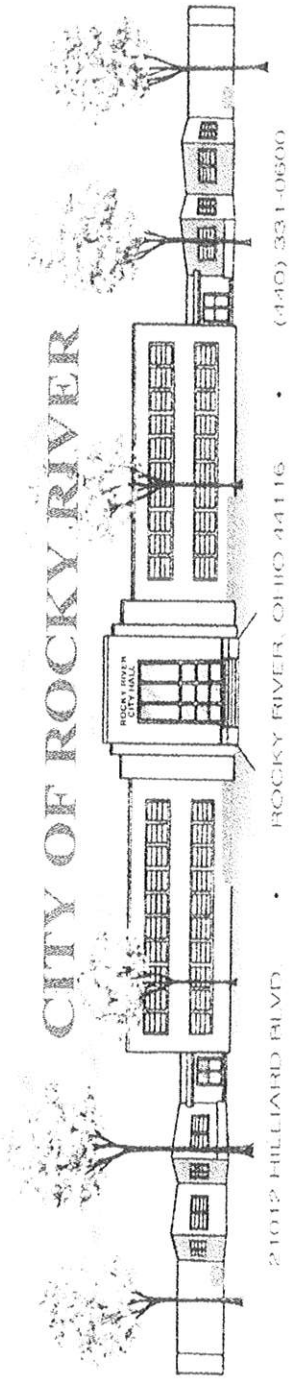

The City received six (6) proposals on May 21, 2021, for the Civic Center Emergency Generator.

Beck Electric Company	\$ 258,500.00	\$ 45,431.00
Lake Erie Electric, Inc.	\$ 262,350.00	\$ 60,561.00
RGT Services, LLC.	\$ 277,480.00	\$ 97,031.00
London Road Electric	\$ 313,950.00	\$ 103,016.00
G & B Electric Company	\$ 319,935.00	

Zenith Systems, LLC, is the electrical contractor for the new Rocky River Police Station and installed a similar emergency generator for the project. They have also installed all electrical and communication hardware for the police station. They have been an excellent contractor to work with and I highly recommend them. Facilities and Maintenance Manager Mike Balla and I have reviewed the proposals and met with the contractor on site with the design engineer from Denk Associates. Based on the proposal, communication with the contractor, and personal experience, we recommend Zenith Systems, LLC as the best and lowest bid. Additionally, a search of the Ohio Auditor of State Finding for Recovery Database shows no findings for Zenith Systems, LLC.

With your permission I will submit an ordinance for this to council for consideration at their next scheduled legislative meeting.
