AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE RECLAMITE LIQUID ASPHALT PAVEMENT PRESERVATION UNDER THE ODOT COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM FROM PAVEMENT TECHNOLOGY, INC., AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$49,932.61, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety Service has determined it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to purchase Reclamite Liquid Asphalt Pavement Preservation for a total cost not to exceed Forty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Two Dollars and 61/100 (\$49,932.61), from Pavement Technology, Inc. under the ODOT Cooperative Purchasing Program, under which ODOT publicly bids products for governmental use annually, as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to purchase Reclamite Liquid Asphalt Pavement Preservation for a total cost not to exceed Forty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Two Dollars and 61/100 (\$49,932.61), from Pavement Technology, Inc., 24144 Detroit Road, Westlake, Ohio 44145 under the State Cooperative Purchasing Act, as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That funds for said purchase shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund-Capital Improvement Roads account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and to participate timely in the ODOT Cooperative Purchasing Program and treat Hilliard Boulevard as soon as possible, at the State's prevailing price, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
