AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CARRON ASPHALT PAVING, INC., FOR THE 2021 LINDEN PARK TENNIS COURT IMPROVEMENTS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$340,872.97, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN ATTACHED EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2021 Linden Park Tennis Court Improvements which will remove and replace the existing tennis courts; and

WHEREAS, three (3) bids were received on June 21, 2021, as further described in Exhibit "A" attached, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends the lowest and best bid from Carron Asphalt Paving, Inc., be accepted in the amount of Three Hundred Forty Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy Two Dollars and 97/100 (\$340,872.97) as further described in Exhibit "A".

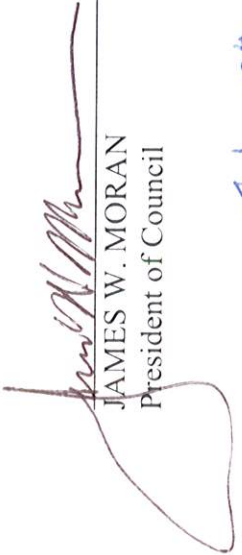
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Carron Asphalt Paving, Inc., 7615 Bond Street, Solon, Ohio, 44139 for the 2021 Linden Park Tennis Court Improvements in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Forty Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy Two Dollars and 97/100 (\$340,872.97), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the cost of the 2021 Linden Park Tennis Court Improvements, shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund-Linden Park account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

We received three bids on June 21, 2021 for the 2021 Linden Park Tennis Court Improvement.

Contractor	Bid	Difference
1. Carron Asphalt Paving, Inc.	\$ 340,872.97*	\$ 0.00
2. SONA Construction, LLC	\$ 410,110.00*	\$ 69,237.03
3. Schirmer Construction, LLC	\$ 485,283.00	\$144,410.03
Engineer's Estimate	\$ 376,000.00	

*indicates bid amount was corrected due to arithmetic errors.

Carron Asphalt Paving, Inc. has previously worked in the City of Fairview Park and successfully completed the project. Carron Asphalt Paving, Inc. has also previously worked in the City of Berea and the Village of Valleyview and for the Midview Local Schools. The Assistant Engineer for the City of Berea and the Engineer for the Village of Valleyview both provided favorable references for Carron Asphalt Paving, Inc.

Carron Asphalt Paving, Inc.. has completed all the required forms in the bid book and provided a copy of a certified search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database showing they are not listed in the database.

I recommend that the contract in the amount of \$340,872.97 be awarded to:
