AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CROSSROADS ASPHALT RECYCLING, INC., FOR THE 2021 STREET REPAIR PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$808,070.75, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2021 Street Repair Program which will provide street and or curb repairs for the following streets: Archwood Drive, Beachcliff Blvd., Kings Mill Run, Kramer Drive, Marllys Drive, Martins Way, Mitchell Avenue, Morewood Alley, North Cliff Drive, Riverdale Drive, South Island Drive and within City owned property at City Hall and Martin Park; and

WHEREAS, five (5) bids were received as further described in Exhibit "A" attached, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends the lowest and best bid from Crossroads Asphalt Recycling, Inc., be accepted in the amount of Eight Hundred Eight Thousand Seventy Dollars and 75/100 (\$808,070.75) as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Crossroads Asphalt Recycling, Inc., 13421 Hawke Road, Columbia Station, Ohio, 44028 for the 2021 Street Repair Program in an amount not to exceed Eight Hundred Eight Thousand Seventy Dollars and 75/100 (\$808,070.75), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the cost of the 2021 Street Repair Program, shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund-Capital Improvement Roads account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

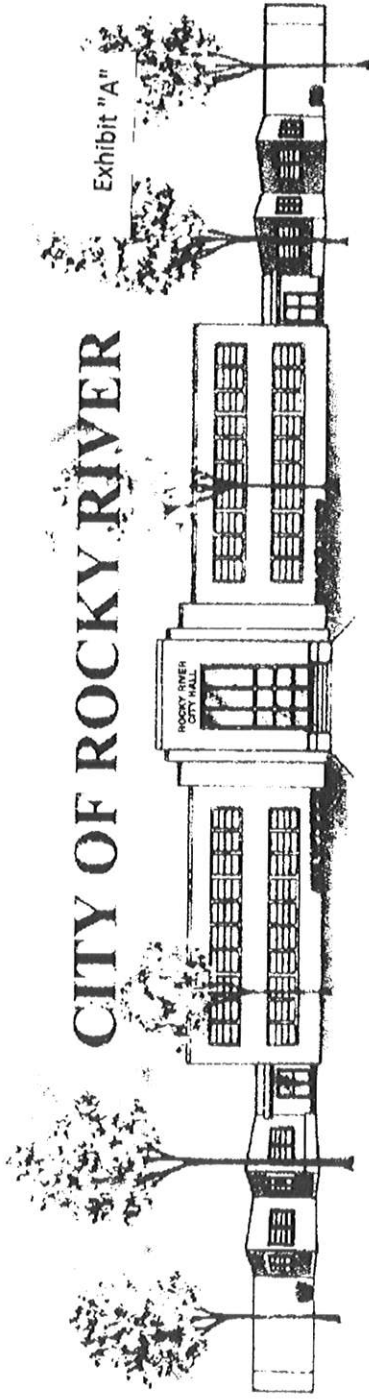
