AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH KONSTRUCTION KING, INC., FOR THE 2021 TREE AND SIDEWALK PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$164,704.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2021 Tree and Sidewalk Program which will provide sidewalk repairs and removal of conflicting trees for Kings Mill Run, Colonial Court, and Kings Post Parkway; and

WHEREAS, one (1) bid was received as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached, copy of which is on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bid and recommends the bid from Konstruction King, Inc., be accepted in the amount of One Hundred Forty Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Four Dollars and 00/100 (\$148,704.00) as further described in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the City Engineer and the Director of Public Safety Service a contingency allowance of Sixteen Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$16,000.00) will be allocated for the sole purpose of paying for unforeseen construction costs not previously outlined in the bid specifications, in addition to the base contract of One Hundred Forty Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Four Dollars and 00/100 (\$148,704.00) for a total cost of One Hundred Sixty Four Thousand Seven Hundred and Four Dollars and 00/100 (\$164,704.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Konstruction King, Inc., 1270 West 130th Street #300, Brunswick, Ohio, 44212 in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Sixty Four Thousand Seven Hundred and Four Dollars and 00/100 (\$164,704.00) as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the 2021 Tree and Sidewalk Program, shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund-Capital Improvement Sidewalk Account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

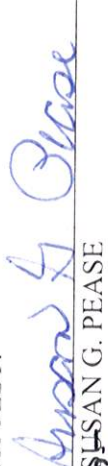

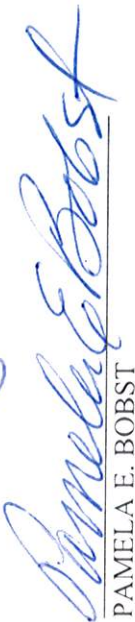

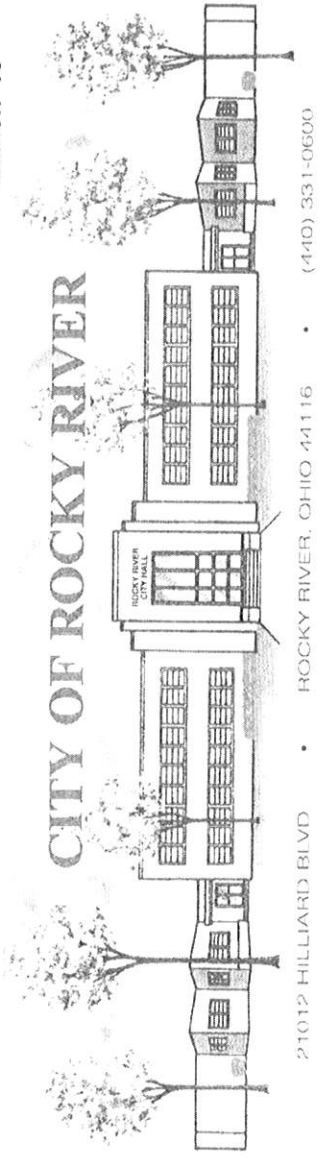

We received one bid on June 18, 2021 for the 2021 Tree & Sidewalk Program.

Konstruktion King, Inc. has previously worked in the City of Rocky River and successfully completed the projects. Konstruktion King, Inc. has also previously worked in the City of Brunswick and the City of Westlake. Both Matt Jones, the Consulting Engineer for the City of Brunswick, and Bob Kelly, City Engineer for City of Westlake, provided favorable references for Konstruktion King.

Konstruktion King, Inc. has completed all the required forms in the bid book and is not listed in the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database.

I recommend that the contract in the amount of \$164,704.00 (Bid of \$148,704.00 and a contingency allowance of \$16,000.00) be awarded to:
