AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY-SERVICE TO EXTEND A CONTRACT FOR ONE (1) YEAR FOR THE PURCHASE OF JANITORIAL SUPPLIES FOR THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER FROM OHIO VALLEY SUPPLY AND MAINTENANCE CO. AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$55,000.00

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service advertised for bids in June of 2019 for the purchase of janitorial supplies for a one (1) year period with the ability to renew on an annual basis, upon agreement of the parties; and

WHEREAS: pursuant to Ordinance No. 62-19 City Council adopted the acceptance of the bid for janitorial supplies from Ohio Valley Supply and Maintenance Co., 2011 St. Clair Ave N.E., Cleveland, Ohio 44114-4047, for one (1) year, which bid included an offer for the City to make annual renewals of this contract upon no increases in price as further described in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS: City Council now determines that it is in the best interest of the City to extend this contract for an additional one (1) year period at a cost not to exceed Fifty Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$55,000.00).

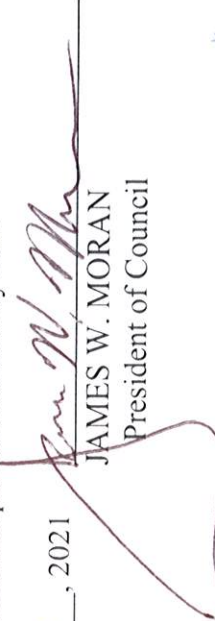
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River be authorized to extend the contract for janitorial supplies from Ohio Valley Supply and Maintenance Co., 2011 St. Clair Ave N.E., Cleveland, Ohio 44114-4047, for an additional one (1) year period in an amount not to exceed Fifty Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$55,000.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the cost of said janitorial supplies shall be charged to the following funds: General, Recreation Center, Waste Water Treatment Plant Utility, Senior Center, Marine Patrol, Refuse & Recycling, Sanitary Sewer and Street Construction Maintenance & Repair, which funds are already appropriated.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

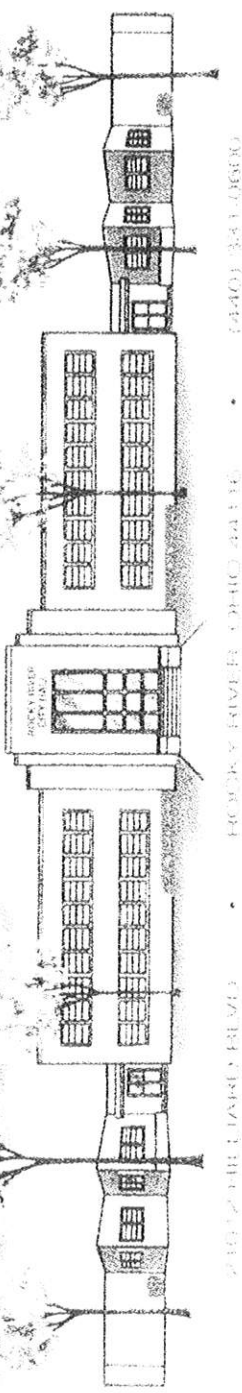
