ORDINANCE NO. 7-21

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER AND JORDAN SERVICES LLC. FOR THE #2 PRIMARY DIGESTER CLEANING PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$712,450.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the City of Rocky River Waste Water Treatment Plant advertised for bids for the Waste Water Treatment Plant #2 Primary Digester Cleaning Project; and

WHEREAS: five (5) bids were received on December 29, 2020, as further described in Exhibit "A" attached, copies of which are on file in the office of the Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent; and

WHEREAS: the Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent has evaluated the bids, and determined the bid of Jordan Services LLC to be the lowest and best bid, and it is recommended that this bid be accepted in the amount of Seven Hundred Twelve Thousand Four Hundred Fifty Dollars and 00/100 (\$712,450.00) as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Jordan Services LLC, 3643 Church Hill Road, Zanesville, OH 43701 in an amount not to exceed Seven Hundred Twelve Thousand Four Hundred and Fifty Dollars and 00/100 (\$712,450.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That \$712,450.00 shall be paid from the WWTP Capital Fund-Contract Repair account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that services referred to above must be expedited in order to comply with NPDES and weather related operational needs, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

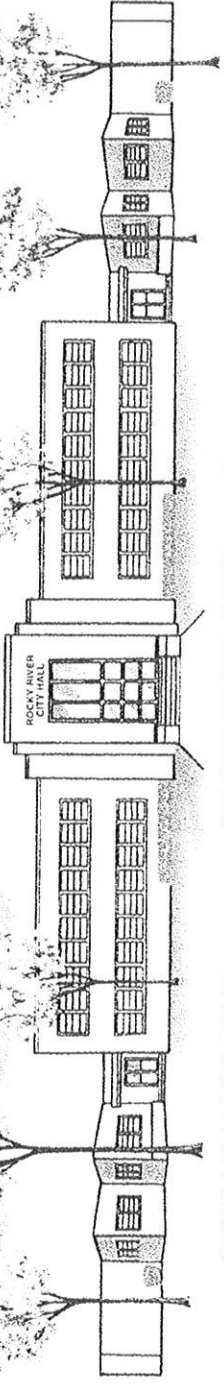
