ORDINANCE NO. 78-21

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY-SERVICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH PVS CHEMICAL SOLUTIONS, INC., FOR THE PURCHASE AND SUPPLY OF SODIUM BISULFITE FOR THE ROCKY RIVER WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AT A COST OF \$1.62 PER GALLON FOR ONE (1) YEAR AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: The Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids with specifications that contain an option to renew on an annual basis for the purchase and supply of Sodium Bisulfite for the Wastewater Treatment Plant starting January 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS: Three (3) bids were received on October 1, 2021 and upon recommendation of the Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent, it was determined to be in the best interest of the City to accept the lowest and best bid of One Dollar and 62/100 (\$1.62) per gallon, for the purchase and supply of Sodium Bisulfite for the Wastewater Treatment Plant from PVS Chemical Solutions, Inc., 10900 Harper Avenue, Detroit, MI 48213 for a period of one (1) year, copies of said bids are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety-Service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized purchase Sodium Bisulfite for a period of one year, with an option to renew from PVS Chemical Solutions, Inc., 10900 Harper Avenue, Detroit, MI 48213 at One Dollar and 62/100 (\$1.62) per gallon, as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That funds for the purchase and supply of Sodium Bisulfite shall be paid from the Wastewater Treatment Plant Utility Fund.

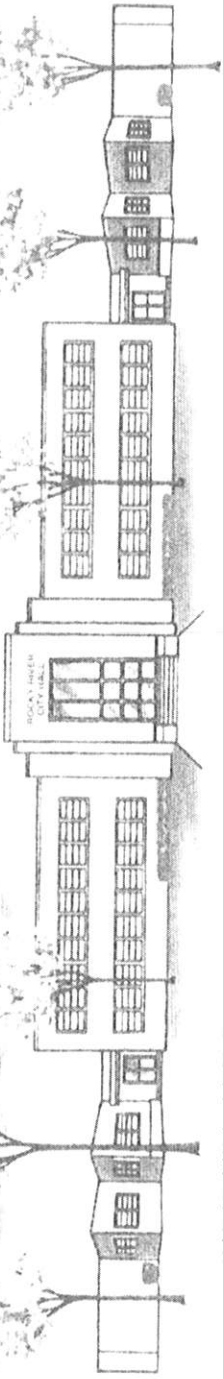
