ORDINANCE NO. 81-21

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO RENEW FOR (1) YEAR THE AGREEMENT WITH KIMBLE COMPANY FOR THE REMOVAL OF DIGESTED SLUDGE CAKE TO A LANDFILL FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AT A COST OF \$46.47 PER TON, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids with specifications that contain an option to renew on an annual basis for the removal of digested sludge cake to a landfill from the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS: pursuant to Ordinance No. 103-20 City Council adopted the acceptance of the bid for the removal of digested sludge cake to a landfill from Kimble Company, 3596 State Route 39 NW, Dover, Ohio 44622, for one (1) year, which bid included an offer for the City to make annual renewals of this contract upon no increases in price, as further described in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS: the Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent and Director of Public Safety Service have determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to authorize renewal of the agreement for one (1) additional year starting December 1, 2021 and ending November 30, 2022 at the price of Forty-Six Dollars and 47/100 (\$46.47) per ton.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to extend the contract for the removal of digested sludge cake to a landfill for an additional one (1) year period, from Kimble Company, 3596 State Route 39 NW, Dover, Ohio 44622 at the price of Forty-Six Dollars and 47/100 (\$46.47) per ton, as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That funds for the removal of digested sludge cake to a landfill shall be paid from the Wastewater Treatment Plant Utility Fund.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

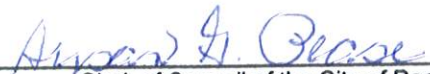

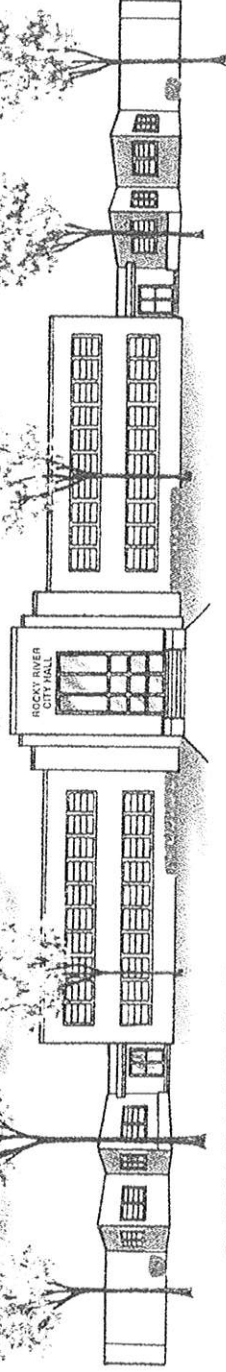
