AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO PURCHASE THREE (3) 2021 FORD HYBRID EXPLORER INTERCEPTORS, TWO (2) FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND ONE (1) FOR THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE UNDER THE OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING ACT FROM VALLEY FORD TRUCK, INC., AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$37,000.00 PER VEHICLE, AS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: Council passed Resolution 20-88 on March 21, 1988 authorizing the Administration to participate in the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Act; and,

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety Service has determined it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to purchase three (3) 2021 Ford Hybrid Explorer Interceptors, two (2) for the Police Department and one (1) for the Director of Public Safety Service at a cost not to exceed \$37,000.00 per vehicle for a total cost of One Hundred Eleven Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$111,000.00), from Valley Ford Truck, Inc., 5715 Canal Road, Cleveland, Ohio, 44125, under the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Act, as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to purchase three (3) 2021 Ford Hybrid Explorer Interceptors, two (2) for the Police Department and one (1) for the Director of Public Safety Service at a cost not to exceed \$37,000.00 per vehicle for a total cost of One Hundred Eleven Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$111,000.00), from Valley Ford Truck, Inc., 5715 Canal Road, Cleveland, Ohio, 44125, under the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Act, as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That funds for said purchase of two (2) vehicles shall be paid from the General Fund – POPAS Vehicles and Large Equipment Account, and one (1) vehicle shall be paid from the Equipment Purchase Fund – SSD Vehicles and Large Equipment Account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and to participate timely in the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing program, at the State's prevailing price, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor: otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

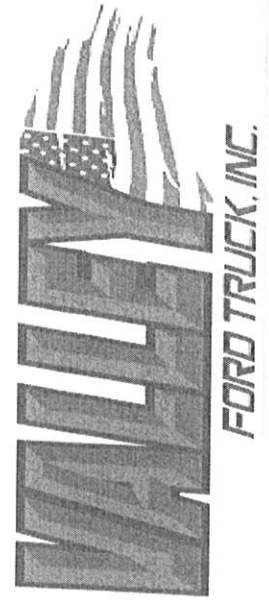
