ORDINANCE NO. 10-22

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE ONE (1) ICE RESURFACING VEHICLE FROM ZAMBONI COMPANY, USA, INC. FOR THE HAMILTON ICE ARENA, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$136,318.95, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Director of Recreation requested proposals for pricing for the purchase of one (1) Ice Resurfacing Vehicle for the Hamilton Ice Arena; and

WHEREAS: two (2) proposals were vetted by the Recreation Department staff, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Recreation; and

WHEREAS: the Director of Recreation has determined it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to select the lowest and best bid for the Ice Resurfacing Vehicle for the Hamilton Ice Arena from Zamboni Company USA, Inc., 15714 Colorado Avenue, Paramount, California 90723 at a total cost not to exceed One Hundred Thirty Six Thousand Three Hundred Eighteen Dollars and 95/100 (\$136,318.95), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to purchase one (1) Ice Resurfacing Vehicle for the Hamilton Ice Arena from Zamboni Company USA, Inc., 15714 Colorado Avenue, Paramount, California 90723 at a total cost not to exceed One Hundred Thirty Six Thousand Three Hundred Eighteen Dollars and 95/100 (\$136,318.95), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That this Ice Resurfacing Vehicle shall be paid for from the Equipment Purchase Fund-Recreation Vehicles and Large Equipment account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and to preserve pricing, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

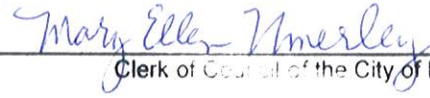

RE: Ice Resurfacing Vehicle

Through reviewing proposals from the two manufactures that build ice resurfacing vehicles, Zamboni and Olympia, Zamboni’s proposal is most in line with the needs and experience of the City of Rocky River.

The City currently owns two Zamboni Company vehicles and utilizes the oldest as a backup. This replacement vehicle would replace the newer of the two and be used as the primary machine while re-classifying the 14 year old model as the ‘backup’.

Though not the lowest in cost, it is recommended that the City of Rocky River purchase the ice resurfacer from the Zamboni Company do to the uniqueness of the piece of equipment. The City mechanics, who have responsibility of vehicle maintenance on the machine, have reviewed the options and strongly recommend keeping the brand consistent for parts and maintenance purposes. Additionally, Recreation Department staff knowledge of the current brand is valuable for daily use and operations.

The purchase has been vetted by both the Parks & Recreation Commission as well as the Recreation Department Staff. Additionally, after a search of Finding for Recovery with the Ohio Auditor of State, the vendor record came back negative.

For reference, the two vendors considered included:
