AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF REPLACEMENT FLOORING FROM SNAPSPO RTS ATHLETIC SURFACES FOR THE HAMILTON ICE ARENA AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$95,500.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Director of Recreation requested proposals for pricing for the purchase of Replacement Flooring for the Hamilton Ice Arena; and

WHEREAS: three (3) proposals were vetted by the Recreation Department staff, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Recreation; and

WHEREAS: the Director of Recreation has determined it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to select the lowest and best bid for the Replacement Flooring for the Hamilton Ice Arena from Snapsports Athletic Surfaces, 2330 California Avenue, Salt Lake City, Utah 84104 at a total cost not to exceed Ninety Five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$95,500.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of the Replacement Flooring for the Hamilton Ice Arena from Snapsports Athletic Surfaces, 2330 California Avenue, Salt Lake City, Utah 84104 at a total cost not to exceed Ninety Five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$95,500.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That \$95,500.00 shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund-Rink Improvements account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that it is necessary to replace the existing turf surface that is in disrepair and to minimize delay for delivery, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MEMORANDUM

RE: Replacement Flooring –Hamilton Ice Arena

Upon completing a thorough review of three vendor proposals related to the replacement of the Hamilton Ice Arena Turf, I would recommend the project be awarded to Snap Sports Athletic Surfaces at a competitive proposal of \$95,500.00. This product would replace the more than 20 year old turf that it utilized for summer programming in the Ice Arena that is beyond its useful life and becoming increasingly more of a risk and safety concern.

The new surface is not a direct replacement of the turf but rather a modular, multipurpose floor that will be lined for a variety of indoor sports. This surface will allow for increased programming and revenue as well as an increased ability to clean & sanitize.

The recommended product has been vetted by both the Parks & Recreation Commission as well as the Recreation Department Staff. Additionally, after a search of Finding for Recovery with the Ohio Auditor of State, the vendor record came back negative.

For reference, the three vendors considered included:
