AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH KARVO COMPANIES, INC. FOR THE WOOSTER ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$598,000.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the Wooster Road Resurfacing project; and,

WHEREAS, six (6) bids were received as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends that the lowest and best bid of Karvo Companies, Inc., be accepted in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Ninety Eight Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$598,000.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Karvo Companies, Inc., 4254 Hudson Drive, Stow, Ohio 44224 for the Wooster Road Resurfacing project in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Ninety Eight Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$598,000.00), as further explained in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That funds for said construction management services shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund-Capital Improvement Roads account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

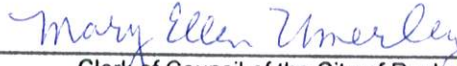

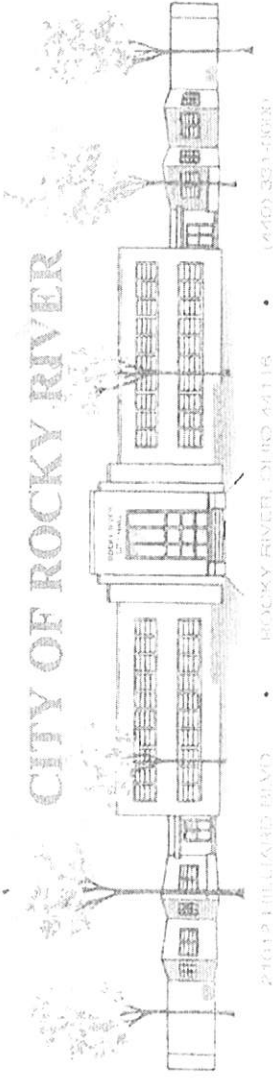

The City received six bids on February 14, 2022 for the CUY-Wooster Road PID 112497 Pavement Resurfacing project.

Karvo Companies, Inc. has the required experience and equipment, and has previously provided this type of work in several cities. Justin Dietz with the city of Elyria, Randy Smith with Trumbull County, Joseph Alfano with ODOT District 4, and James Gills, the Lake County Engineer, all gave favorable recommendations. Karvo Companies, Inc. is ODOT prequalified and has satisfactorily completed several ODOT projects with multiple ODOT projects awarded to them for this fiscal year. The City also talked with ODOT District 12 and they indicated that Karvo Companies, Inc. has complied with the ODOT prequalifications and DBE requirements.

Karvo Companies, Inc. has completed all required forms in the bid book and provided a copy of a search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database showing they are not listed in the database.

I recommend that the contract in the amount of \$ 598,000.00 be awarded to
