ORDINANCE NO. 2-22

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FABRIZI TRUCKING AND PAVING COMPANY, INC. FOR THE 2022 WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT FOR MALVERN AVENUE AND TELBIR AVENUE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,186,286.75, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2022 Water Main Replacement for Malvern Avenue and Telbir Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, five (5) bids were received as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends that the lowest and best bid of Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Company, Inc., be accepted in an amount not to exceed One Million One Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Six Dollars and 75/100 (\$1,186,286.75), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Company, Inc., 6751 Eastland Road, Middleburg Heights, OH 44130 for the 2022 Water Main Replacement for Malvern Avenue and Telbir Avenue in an amount not to exceed \$1,186,286.75.

SECTION 2. That \$1,186,286.75 shall be paid from the Sewer Rehabilitation Fund - Construction and Improvements account.

SECTION 3. That the City will be reimbursed by Cleveland Water Division through the Suburban Water Main Renewal Program.

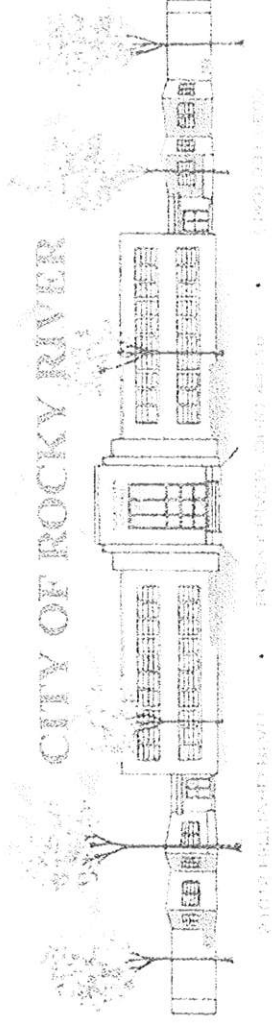

The City received five bids on December 17, 2021 for the 2022 Rocky River Water Main Replacement and Pavement Resurfacing Project.

Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co., Inc. has the required experience and equipment, and has previously provided this type of work in the City of Rocky River and the City of Fairview Park. Fabrizio Trucking & Paving Co., Inc. has also completed similar projects in the City of Elyria, the City of Medina, and the City of Bedford. Kathy McKillips, the Assistant Engineer for the City of Elyria, Patrick Patton, the City of Medina Engineer, and Nick Fini, the City of Bedford Engineer all gave favorable recommendations for Fabrizio Trucking & Paving Co., Inc.

Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co., Inc. has completed all required forms in the bid book and provided a copy of a search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database showing they are not listed in the database.

Approval of Awarding of Contract
Malvern and Telbir Avenues Water Main
Replacement Project

Dear Mr. Snyder:

The Cleveland Water Division (CWD) has reviewed the tabulation of the bids received by the City of Rocky River for the Malvern and Telbir Avenues Water Main Replacement Project. Your community will be reimbursed for the eligible water main replacement costs for this project as part of our Suburban Water Main Renewal Program, subject to the reimbursement terms of your Water Service Agreement.

Our review has not found any major issues with the bids received. Therefore, please consider this letter to be CWD approval of the awarding of the contract to your low bidder for this project. It is our understanding that the low bidder is Fabrizio Trucking and Paving Company, Inc. in the amount of \$ 1,186,286.75 for all elements of the project (water main and pavement replacement) and the awarding of a contract to that firm in the referenced amount for this project is hereby approved.

As correctly stated within the bid tabulation documents, this project was submitted for funding consideration and was ultimately scored as and received funding as a combined project. Thus, the reimbursement for eligible water main related construction costs is limited and it is subject to an allowable per foot maximum as specified in the SWMR program reimbursement terms and conditions (contained in Exhibit F of the Water Service Agreement).

The SWMR program per foot maximum for reimbursement of eligible water main replacement costs for combined projects bid in 2021 is \$ 248.09 per Linear Foot of main replaced. However, based upon the analysis provided in the bid tabulation, the calculated cost of the water main replacement for the estimated 2,478 LF of main to be

replaced contained in the bid items exceeds the allowable per foot maximum. Thus, we are approving the allowable per foot maximum amount of \$614,767.02 for the water main related items for reimbursement at this time.

Please be aware that the actual final amount of eligible reimbursement for water main construction will be determined at project close out and financial reconciliation. If, for some reason, at that time the actual cost of the water main divided by the actual linear feet of water main replaced is less than the referenced per foot maximum, then the actual cost of the water main construction would apply as the amount to be reimbursed.

We look forward to working with your community toward a successful completion of this project. Thank You for partnering with CWD on suburban water main renewal.
