AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SPECIALIZED CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE 2022 CRACK & JOINT SEALING PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$59,950.00 AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2022 Crack & Joint Sealing Program which commences during this summer season; and

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were received on March 18, 2022, as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service and City Engineer have evaluated the bids and recommend that the lowest and best bid from Specialized Construction, Inc., be accepted in the amount of Fifty Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars and 00/100 (\$59,950.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor of the City of Rocky River and Safety Service Director are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Specialized Construction, Inc., 711 Harvard Ave., Cuyahoga Hts., Ohio, 44105, in an amount not to exceed Fifty Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars and 00/100 (\$59,950.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the cost of the 2022 Crack and Joint Sealing Project shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund – Crack Sealing account.

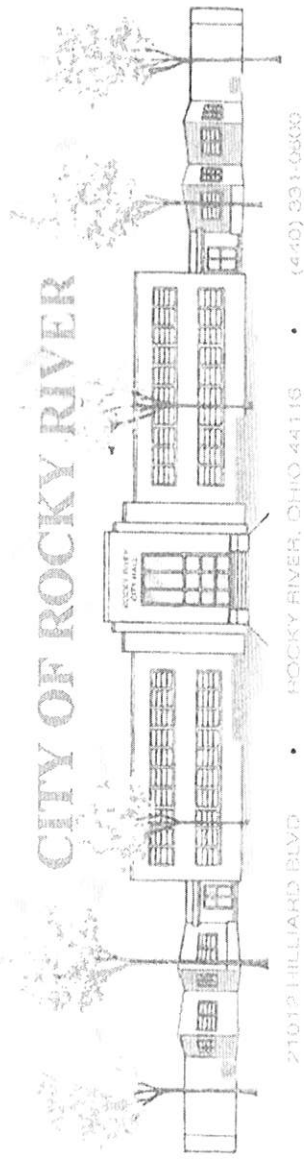

We received two bids on March 18, 2022 for the 2022 Rocky River Crack & Joint Sealing Program.

Contractor	Bid	Difference
1. Specialized Construction, Inc.	\$ 59,950.00	\$ 0.00
2. American Pavements, Inc.	\$ 85,000.00	\$ 25,050.00
Engineer's Estimate	\$ 60,000.00	

Specialized Construction, Inc. has previously worked in the City of Rocky River and satisfactorily completed the project. Specialized Construction, Inc. has also previously worked on crack and joint sealing programs in the City of North Olmsted and the City of Independence. Pietro DiFranco, the City of North Olmsted Engineer and Don Ramm, the City of Independence Engineer, both provided a favorable reference for Specialized Construction, Inc.

Specialized Construction, Inc. has completed all the required forms in the bid book and provided a copy of a certified search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database showing they are not listed in the database.
