AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO PURCHASE PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT FOR MORLEY PARK FROM SNIDER RECREATION INC. AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$64,760.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Director of Recreation requested proposals for pricing for the purchase of new Playground Equipment for Morley Park; and

WHEREAS: six (6) proposals were vetted by the Parks and Recreation Commission, Parks and Recreation Foundation as well as the Recreation Department staff, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Recreation; and

WHEREAS: the Director of Recreation along with the Director of Public Safety Service have determined it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to select the lowest and best bid for the Playground Equipment for Morley Park from Snider Recreation, 10139 Royalton Road #K, North Royalton, Ohio, 44133, at a total cost not to exceed Sixty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Dollars and 00/100 (\$64,760.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River be and is hereby authorized to purchase Playground Equipment for Morley Park from Snider Recreation, 10139 Royalton Road #K, North Royalton, Ohio, 44133, at a cost not to exceed Sixty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Dollars and 00/100 (\$64,760.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That \$64,760.00 for the cost of said playground equipment shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund - Morley Park account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that it is necessary to replace playground equipment that is in disrepair and to minimize delay for delivery, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

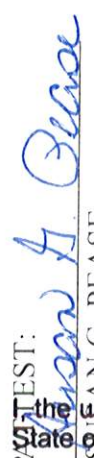

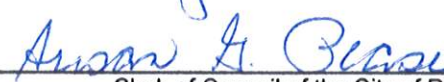

RE: Morley Park Playground

Upon completing a thorough review of six vendor proposals related to the replacement of the Morley Park Playground, I would recommend the project be awarded to Snider Recreation at the competitive price of \$64,760.00. This structure would be replacing the current playground that was installed approximately 20 years ago.

Removal of current structure and excavation of space will completed by the City. Installation of new equipment and wood fibar to be completed by Snider with an average lead time of between six and eight weeks for standard items. The structure will meet all ADA requirements and be built with approximately 35% recycled product.

The attached Burke Product design has been shared with the Parks & Recreation Commission, Parks & Recreation Foundation as well as the Recreation Department Staff. Additionally, after a search of Finding for Recovery with the Ohio Auditor of State, the vendor record came back negative.

Snider has been selected because of the overall play-value that includes various elements that allow for children 2-12 years of age to participate as well as several unique pieces that make the structure(s) slightly more diverse.
