ORDINANCE NO. 27-22

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF OHIO TO ACCEPT A GRANT UP TO \$35,000.00 FOR THE OPERATION OF THE MARINE PATROL FOR THE YEAR 2022 AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: The City of Rocky River desires to maintain participation with the State of Ohio, Department of Natural Resources, in the Marine Patrol program for the year 2022, wherein the City will receive up to \$35,000.00 from the State of Ohio upon execution of the Marine Patrol Assistance Agreement with the State; and

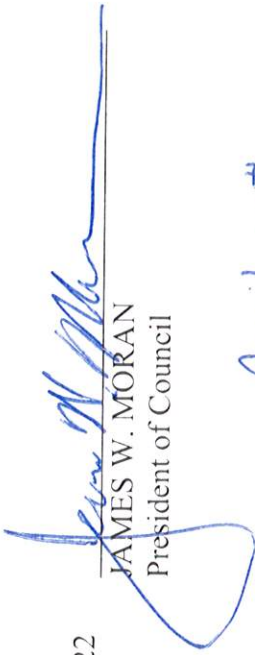
WHEREAS: City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City to authorize the Mayor to enter into the 2022 Marine Patrol Assistance Program with the State of Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with the State of Ohio whereby the State of Ohio will grant up to \$35,000.00 to the Rocky River Police Department for the operation of the Marine Patrol for the year 2022, as further described in the attached award letter (Exhibit A).

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that the Ordinance must be passed and returned to the Division of Parks and Watercraft by May 6, 2022, unless an extension is requested by May 21, 2022, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

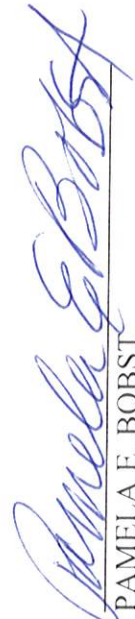

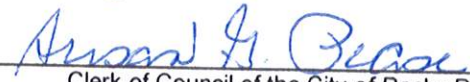
