ORDINANCE NO. 31-22

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FABRIZI TRUCKING AND PAVING COMPANY, INC., FOR PHASE TWO OF THE 2020 ROCKY RIVER SEWER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FOR COLLVER ROAD AND OAK ROAD STORM SEWER, SANITARY SEWER, WATER MAIN AND PAVEMENT REPLACEMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,509,386.60, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the Collver Road and Oak Road Storm Sewer, Sanitary Sewer, Water Main & Pavement Replacement; and

WHEREAS, three (3) bids were received on May 6, 2022, as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service and engineering consultants from Mackay Engineering have evaluated the bids and recommend that the lowest and best bid from Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Company, Inc., be accepted in an amount not to exceed One Million Five Hundred Nine Thousand Three Hundred Eighty Six Dollars and 60/100 (\$1,509,386.60), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

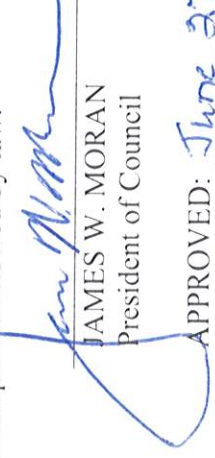
SECTION 1. That the Mayor of the City of Rocky River and Safety Service Director are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Company, Inc., 20389 First Avenue, Middleburg Heights, OH 44130, in an amount not to exceed One Million Five Hundred Nine Thousand Three Hundred Eighty Six Dollars and 60/100 (\$1,509,386.60), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the cost of the Collver Road and Oak Road Storm Sewer, Sanitary Sewer, Water Main and Pavement Replacement shall be paid from the Sewer Rehabilitation Fund – Construction and Improvements account.

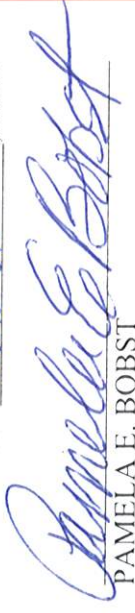
SECTION 3. That the City will be reimbursed for the water main replacement by Cleveland Water Division through the Suburban Water Main Renewal Program.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately to allow the City to fully use the construction season ahead and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

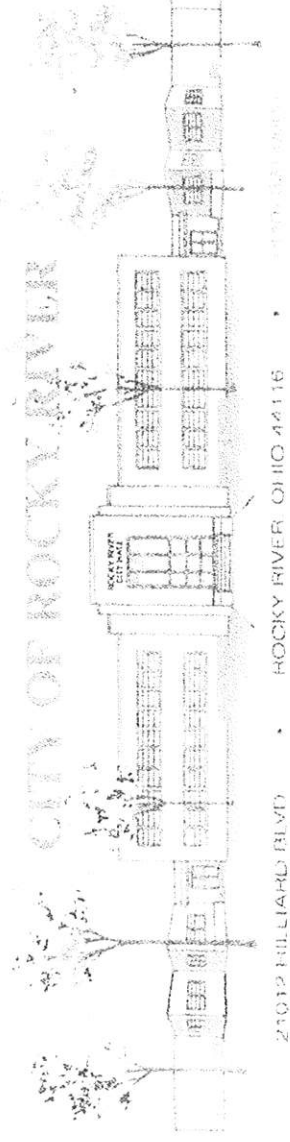

The City received three bids on May 6, 2022 for the 2022 Collver Road & Oak Road Storm Sewer, Sanitary Sewer, Water Main and Pavement Replacement project.

2. DiGioia-Suburban Excavating, LLC	\$ 1,816,463.85	\$ 307,077.25
3. Mr. Excavator, Inc.	\$ 2,085,524.90	\$ 576,138.30
Engineer's Estimate	\$ 1,900,000.00	

Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Co., Inc. has the required experience and equipment, and has previously provided this type of work to the City of Rocky River and has also completed similar projects in the City of Elyria, the City of Seven Hills and the City of Olmsted Falls. Kathryn McKillips, the City of Elyria Engineer, Mark Schmitzer, the City of Seven Hills Engineer, and Don Sheehy, the Engineer for the City of Olmsted Falls all gave favorable recommendations for Fabrizio Trucking and Paving Co., Inc.
