ORDINANCE NO. 33-22

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FABRIZI TRUCKING AND PAVING COMPANY, INC., FOR THE SPENCER ROAD SEWER AND PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENT PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,289,929.38 AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the Spencer Road Sewer and Pavement Improvement project; and

WHEREAS, one (1) bid was received on April 29, 2022, as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached, copy of which is on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service and engineering consultants from Mackay Engineering have evaluated the bid and recommend that the bid from Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Company, Inc., be accepted in an amount not to exceed One Million Two Hundred Eighty Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty Nine Dollars and 38/100 (\$1,289,929.38), as further described in Exhibit "A".

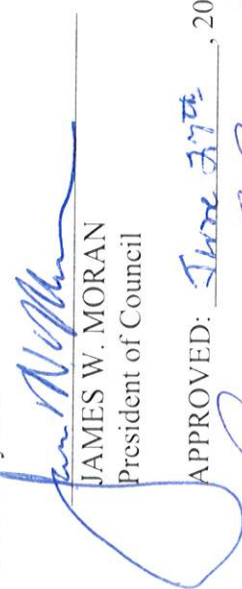
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor of the City of Rocky River and the Director of Public Safety Service are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Company, Inc., 6751 Eastland Road, Middleburg Heights, OH 44130, in an amount not to exceed One Million Two Hundred Eighty Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty Nine Dollars and 38/100 (\$1,289,929.38), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the cost of the Spencer Road Sewer and Pavement Improvement shall be paid from the Sewer Rehabilitation Fund – Construction and Improvements account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately to allow the City to fully use the construction season ahead and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

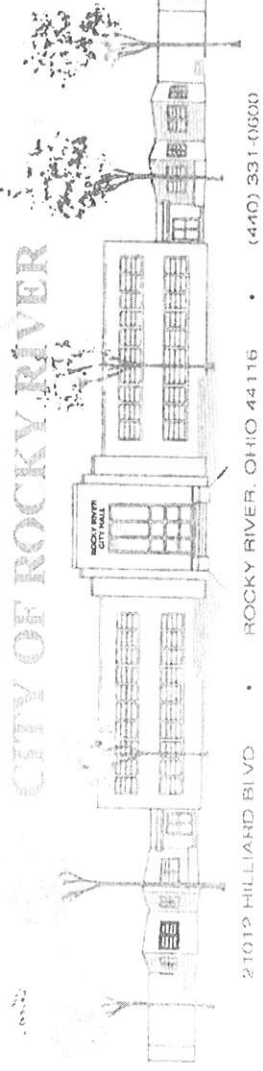

The City received one bid on April 29, 2022 for the 2022 Rocky River Spencer Road Sewer and Pavement Improvement Project.

Engineer's Estimate	\$ 1,850,000.00	

Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co., Inc. has the required experience and equipment, and has previously provided this type of work in the City of Rocky River, the City of South Euclid and the City of Olmsted Falls. Andrew Blackley, the Engineer for the City of South Euclid and Don Sheehy, the Engineer for the City of Olmsted Falls both gave favorable recommendations for Fabrizio Trucking & Paving Co., Inc.

Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co., Inc. has completed all required forms in the bid book and provided a copy of a search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database showing they are not listed in the database.
