ORDINANCE NO. 34-22

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE TWO (2) 25 CUBIC YARD TRAILER MOUNTED SELF-CONTAINED VACUUM LEAF COLLECTORS FOR THE SERVICE DIVISION FROM BELL EQUIPMENT COMPANY, AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$230,384.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the purchase of two (2) 25 Cubic Yard Trailer Mounted Self-Contained Vacuum Leaf Collectors for the Service Division; and

WHEREAS: three (3) bids were received on April 29, 2022, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety Service has determined it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to select the best bid from Bell Equipment Company at a total cost not to exceed Two Hundred Thirty Thousand Three Hundred Eighty Four Dollars and 00/100, (\$230,384.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Safety Service Director of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to purchase two (2) 25 Cubic Yard Trailer Mounted Self-Contained Vacuum Leaf Collectors for the Service Division from Bell Equipment Company, 1045 Taylor Road, Gahanna, Ohio 43230, at a total cost not to exceed Two Hundred Thirty Thousand Three Hundred Eighty Four Dollars and 00/100, (\$230,384.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the cost of (2) 25 Cubic Yard Trailer Mounted Self-Contained Vacuum Leaf Collectors shall be paid for from the Equipment Purchase Fund-Refuse and Recycling Vehicles and Large Equipment account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and to preserve pricing, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

The City received three (3) bids on April 29, 2022 for the purchase of two (2) 25 Cubic Yard Trailer Mounted Self-Contained Vacuum Leaf Collectors for the Service Division.

Bell Equipment Company	\$230,384.00**
Southeastern Equipment Company, Inc.	\$198,998.00
Best Equipment Company, Inc.	\$243,098.00
**Includes \$3,000 for freight	

Upon review of the bid and products specified by all vendors, the Service Commissioner, Lead Mechanic, and Lead Supervisor of the Streets Department all agree that the product from Bell Equipment Company is the best product at the best price. The Spartan unit from Bell Equipment Company appears to have the most durable construction, provide the best safety for the operator, and is best suited for our collection method.

The City of Independence utilizes this product for their leaf collection and is very pleased. They are planning on purchasing an additional unit this year.

A search of the Auditor of State's Database for Findings for Recovery displays no results for Bell Equipment Company.
