ORDINANCE NO. 39-22

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FABRIZI TRUCKING AND PAVING COMPANY, INC. FOR THE 2022 WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT AND PAVEMENT RESURFACING FOR ERIE ROAD, FAIRHILL DRIVE AND NELSON PARK DRIVE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,549,471.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2022 Water Main Replacement and Pavement Resurfacing for Erie Road, Fairhill Drive and Nelson Park Drive; and,

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were received as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends that the lowest and best bid of Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Company, Inc., be accepted in an amount not to exceed Two Million Five Hundred Forty Nine Thousand Four Hundred Seventy One Dollars and 00/100 (\$2,549,471.00) further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Company, Inc., 6751 Eastland Road, Middleburg Heights, OH 44130 for the 2022 Water Main Replacement and Pavement Resurfacing for Erie Road, Fairhill Drive and Nelson Park Drive in an amount not to exceed Two Million Five Hundred Forty Nine Thousand Four Hundred Seventy One Dollars and 00/100 (\$2,549,471.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the cost of the 2022 Water Main Replacement and Pavement Resurfacing for Erie Road, Fairhill Drive and Nelson Park Drive shall be paid from the Sewer Rehabilitation Fund – Construction and Improvements account.

SECTION 3. That the City will be reimbursed by Cleveland Water Division through the Suburban Water Main Renewal Program.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately to allow the City to fully use the construction season ahead and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

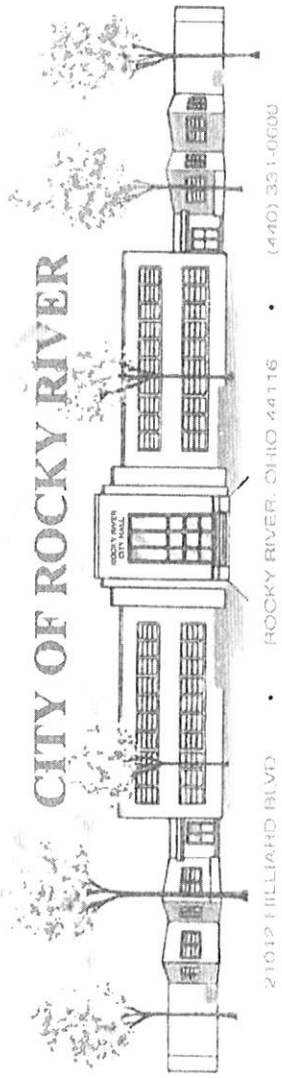

The City received two bids on May 20, 2022 for the 2022 Rocky River Water Main Replacement and Pavement Resurfacing Project

Contractor	Bid	Difference
1. Fabrizio Trucking & Paving Co., Inc.	\$ 2,549,471.00	
2. Terrace Construction Co., Inc.	\$ 2,577,635.86	\$ 28,164.86
Engineer's Estimate	\$ 2,500,000.00	

Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co., Inc. has the required experience and equipment, and has previously provided this type of work in the City of Rocky River and the City of Fairview Park. Fabrizio Trucking & Paving Co., Inc. has also completed similar projects in Lorain County, the City of Elyria, and the City of Bedford. Robert Klaiber, the Assistant Engineer for Lorain County, Justin Dietz with the City of Elyria, and Nick Fini, the City of Bedford Engineer for Lorain County, Justin Dietz with the City of Trucking & Paving Co., Inc.

Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co., Inc. has completed all required forms in the bid book and provided a copy of a search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database showing they are not listed in the database.
