AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH F. P. ALLEGA CONCRETE CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION FOR THE 2022 SIDEWALK PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$196,482.24, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2022 Sidewalk Program which will provide sidewalk repairs in areas where tree root systems or sewer lateral failures in the City right-of-way have caused damage to City sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were received on July 15, 2022, as further described in Exhibit "A" attached, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

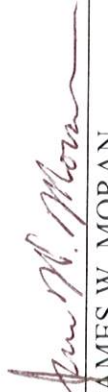
WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bids and recommends the lowest and best bid from F. P. Allega Concrete Construction Corporation, be accepted in the amount of One Hundred Ninety Six Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Two Dollars and 24/100 (\$196,482.24) as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with F. P. Allega Concrete Construction Corporation, 7725 Commerce Park Oval, Suite B, Independence, Ohio 44131, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Ninety Six Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Two Dollars and 24/100 (\$196,482.24), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the 2022 Sidewalk Program, shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund-Capital Improvement Sidewalks.

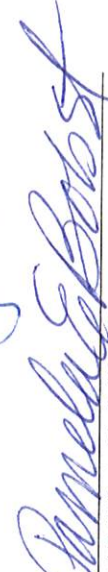
SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

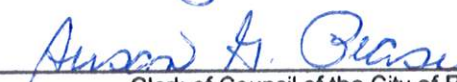

F.P. Allega Concrete Construction Corp. has previously worked in the City of Rocky River and the City of Fairview Park and satisfactorily completed the projects.
