AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CROSSROADS ASPHALT RECYCLING, INC., FOR THE 2022 STREET REPAIR PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,265,407.65, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2022 Street Repair Program which will provide street and or curb repairs for the following streets: Westway, Morewood, East Shoreland, Linden Park and Tri City Park and City Hall parking lots; and

WHEREAS, one (1) bid was received on July 15, 2022, as further described in Exhibit "A" attached, copy of which is on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bid and recommends the lowest and best bid from Crossroads Asphalt Recycling, Inc., be accepted in the amount of One Million Two Hundred Sixty Five Thousand Four Hundred Seven Dollars and 65/100, (\$1,265,407.65) as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Crossroads Asphalt Recycling, Inc., 13421 Hawke Road, Columbia Station, Ohio, 44028 for the 2022 Street Repair Program in an amount not to exceed One Million Two Hundred Sixty Five Thousand Four Hundred Seven Dollars and 65/100, (\$1,265,407.65), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the cost of the 2022 Street Repair Program, shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund-Capital Improvement Roads account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

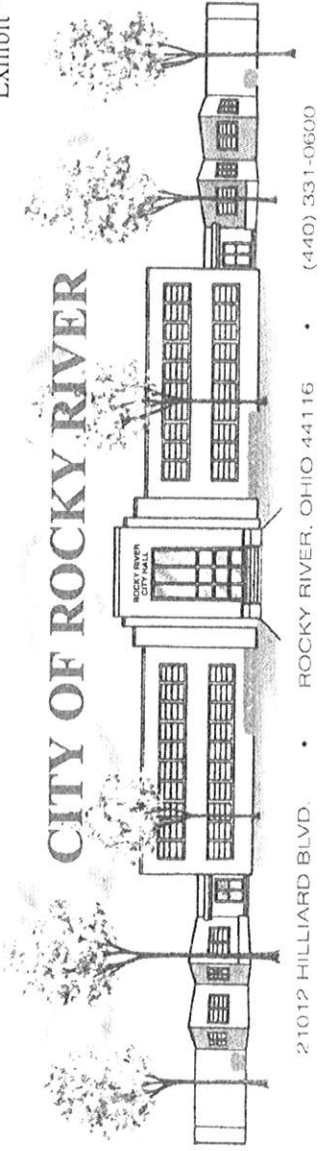

We received one bid on July 15, 2022 for the 2022 Rocky River Street Repair Program (Rebid).

1. Crossroads Asphalt Recycling, Inc.	\$ 1,484,783.40	\$ 134,798.40
Engineer's Estimate	\$ 1,350,000.00	

Crossroads Asphalt Recycling, Inc. has previously worked in the City of Rocky River and the City of Fairview Park and satisfactorily completed the projects.

Crossroads Asphalt Recycling, Inc. has completed all the required forms in the bid book and provided a copy of a certified search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database showing they are not listed in the database.

The work on Beaconsfield Boulevard and Dorothy Avenue will be performed through the 2022 Asphalt Recycling Contract; therefore, \$219,375.75 will be deducted from Crossroads' bid to calculate the amount to be awarded to Crossroads.

I recommend that the contract in the amount of \$1,265,407.65 be awarded to:
