AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT A NEW FUND ENTITLED "ONEOHIO OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUND", FUND NUMBER 221, TO ACCOUNT FOR THE RECEIPT AND EXPENDITURE OF MONIES RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THE STATE OF OHIO ONE OHIO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

WHEREAS, through Resolution No. 61-21, the City accepted the material terms of the State of Ohio One Ohio Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revise Code Section 5705.09(F) requires the City to establish a special fund for each class of revenues derived from a source other than general property tax which the law requires to be used for a particular purpose, and

WHEREAS, in his Bulletin 2022-003, the Auditor of State outlined recommendations for the accounting for the local government share of the MOU resources, and

WHEREAS, the City will be qualified to receive and should be prepared to accept the transfer or disbursement of monies for approved purposes which are evidence-based forward-looking strategies, programming and services to address: expanding the availability of treatment for individuals affected by substance use disorders; developing, promoting and providing evidence-based substance use prevention strategies; providing substance use avoidance and awareness education; decreasing the oversupply of licit and illicit opioids, and supporting recovery for addiction services performed by qualified and appropriately licensed providers; and

WHEREAS, if the City seeks reimbursement for a prior expenditure that meets the approved purposes, the City must have Council authorization for each reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Administration to establish a separate fund entitled "OneOhio Opioid Settlement Fund" to demonstrate compliance, accountability, transparency and efficiency to the residents of the City pursuant to the One Ohio MOU funding provided to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That there is hereby established a separate "OneOhio Opioid Settlement Fund", Fund Number 221, for the purpose of accounting for the receipt of funds to demonstrate compliance, accountability, transparency and efficiency to the residents of the City pursuant to the One Ohio MOU funding provided to the City.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary that this legislation go into effect immediately in order to establish said "OneOhio Opioid Settlement Fund" and begin receiving funds that will assist the community; and further provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members of Council, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
