AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ANGELO BENEDETTI, INC., FOR THE 2022 ASPHALT SURFACE RECYCLING PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$237,037.50, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2022 Asphalt Surface Recycling Program; and

WHEREAS, one (1) bid was received on July 8, 2022, as further described in Exhibit "A" attached, copy of which is on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bid and recommends the lowest and best bid from Angelo Benedetti, Inc., be accepted in the amount of Two Hundred Thirty Seven Thousand Thirty Seven Dollars and 50/100, (\$237,037.50) as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Angelo Benedetti, Inc., _____ for the 2022 Asphalt Surface Recycling Program in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Thirty Seven Thousand Thirty Seven Dollars and 50/100, (\$237,037.50), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the cost of the 2022 Asphalt Surface Recycling Program, shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund-Capital Improvement Roads account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
