ORDINANCE NO. 56-22

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH A & A SAFETY, INC. FOR THE 2022 ROAD STRIPING PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$121,819.35, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2022 Road Striping Project which commences during this fall season; and

WHEREAS, one (1) bid was received on August 26, 2022, as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached, copy of which is on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service and City Engineer have evaluated the bid and recommend that the bid from A & A Safety, Inc., be accepted in the amount of One Hundred Twenty One Thousand Eight Hundred Nineteen Dollars and 35/100 (\$121,819.35), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor of the City of Rocky River and Safety Service Director are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with A & A Safety, Inc., 1126 Ferris Road, Amelia, Ohio, 45102, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Twenty One Thousand Eight Hundred Nineteen Dollars and 35/100 (\$121,819.35), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the cost of the 2022 Road Striping Project shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund – Capital Improvement Roads account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

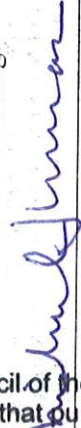

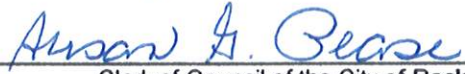

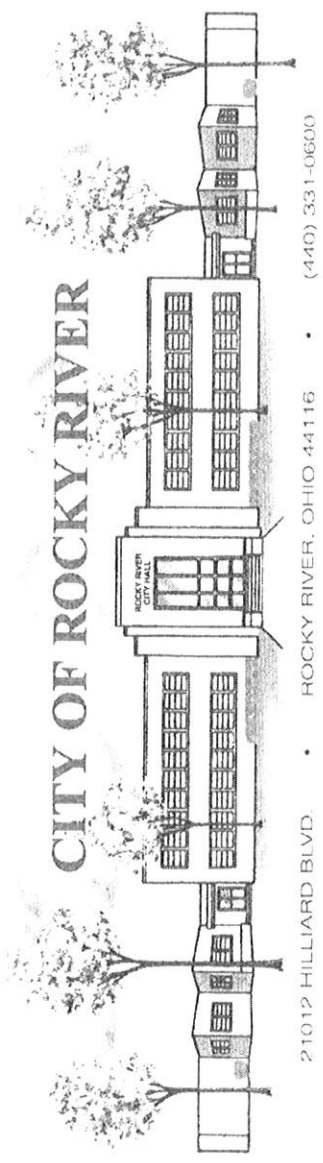
