AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER APPLY FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION'S STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND REVOLVING LOAN PROGRAM FOR THE FUNDING OF THE ROCKY RIVER WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT CEPT AND FINAL CLARIFIER REHABILITATION PROJECT(S)

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvements Program and Revolving Loan Program under the Ohio the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rocky River is planning to make capital improvements to the Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP) via the project known as the WWTP CEPT & Final Clarifier Rehabilitation Project(s); and

WHEREAS, it has been determined through Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the WWTP Long Term Capital Improvements plan that it is necessary for the City of Rocky River to submit applications for financial assistance for the management of the Rocky River Wastewater Treatment Plant on behalf of all member Cities, including Bay Village, Fairview Park, Rocky River and Westlake and,

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvements described herein are considered to be an environmental priority need for the WWTP and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that this agreement is necessary to receive authority to proceed with the application as proposed, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

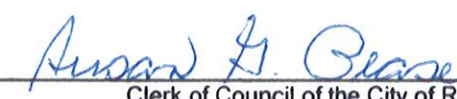
