ORDINANCE NO. 74-22

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY-SERVICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH RUPLE TRUCKING LLC. FOR THE REMOVAL OF DIGESTED SLUDGE CAKE (WINTER SEASON) FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AT A COST OF \$56.99 PER TON FOR ONE (1) YEAR AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: The Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids with specifications that contain an option to renew on an annual basis for the removal of digested sludge cake from the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS: October 18, 2022, two (2) bids were received and upon recommendation of the Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent, it was determined to be in the best interest of the City to accept the lowest and best bid for the removal of digested sludge cake from the Wastewater Treatment Plant from Ruple Trucking LLC, for a period of one (1) year, copies of bids are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to purchase services for the removal of digested sludge cake for a period of one year, with an option to renew from Ruple Trucking, 3950 Ben Hur Avenue, Willoughby, Ohio 44094 at the price of \$56.99 per ton.

SECTION 2. That funds for the removal of digested sludge cake to a municipal landfill shall be paid from the Wastewater Treatment Plant Utility Fund.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that services referred to above must be expedited in order to comply with NPDES and funding source requirements, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
