ORDINANCE NO. 20-23

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO PURCHASE ELECTRICAL SERVICES AS NEEDED FROM HERBST ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR THE ROCKY RIVER WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$48,500.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, The City of Rocky River has determined a need to purchase electrical services to perform an Electrical Maintenance Analysis (EMA) which is essential to maintain plant compliance and perform any necessary repairs; and

WHEREAS, The WWTP Superintendent received three (3) proposals from electrical service providers that satisfy the unique and optimal operational services shown in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, The WWTP Superintendent evaluated the proposals and recommend the proposal from Herbst Electric Company be accepted in an amount not to exceed Forty-Eight Thousand, Five Hundred 00/100 Dollars (\$48,500.00), with prices for said services further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Safety Service is hereby authorized to purchase electrical services from Herbst Electric Company, 5171 Grant Ave., Cuyahoga Heights, OH 44125, for the Rocky River Wastewater Treatment Plant at a total cost not to exceed Forty-Eight Thousand, Eight Hundred Dollars (\$48,500.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the purchase shall be paid from the Wastewater Treatment Plant Utility Fund and Capital Improvement Fund.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that services referred to above must be expedited in order to comply with NPDES and funding source requirements, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Three (3) proposals were received for the WWTP Electrical Maintenance Analysis (EMA) Services:

1. Herbst Electric Company.	\$ 28,500.00	
2. Lake Erie Electric Company	\$ 28,800.00	\$ 300.00
3. The Fowler Company	\$ 109,200.00	\$ 80,400.00

Wastewater Treatment Plant Superintendent Barille has reviewed the quotes and recommends Herbst Electric Company to provide services which best apply to current operations and were the lowest bid. With your permission I will submit an ordinance for this to Council for consideration at their next scheduled legislative meeting.
