AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RMH CONCRETE & FOUNDATIONS, INC., FOR BEACHCLIFF BOULEVARD TLCI PEDESTRIAN CROSSING IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$225,496.40, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A".

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the Beachcliff Boulevard TLCI Pedestrian Crossing Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were received on March 13, 2023, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer along with the Director of Public Safety Service have evaluated the bids and recommend the lowest and best bid from RMH Concrete & Foundations, Inc., be accepted in the amount of Two Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Six Dollars and 40/100 (\$225,496.40), as further described in the attached Exhibit "A".

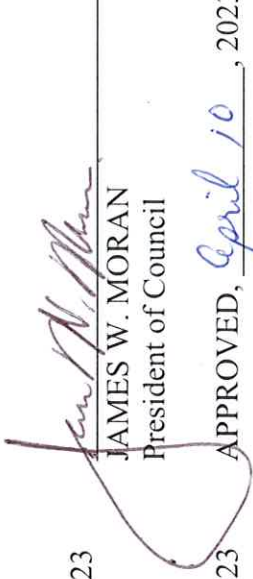
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with RMH Concrete & Foundations, Inc., 4433 West Collins Road, Collins, OH 44826 for the Beachcliff Boulevard TLCI Pedestrian Crossing Improvement Project in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Four Hundred Ninety Six Dollars and 40/100 (\$225,496.40), as further described in the attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the cost of the Beachcliff Boulevard TLCI Pedestrian Crossing Improvement Project shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund-Sidewalk account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

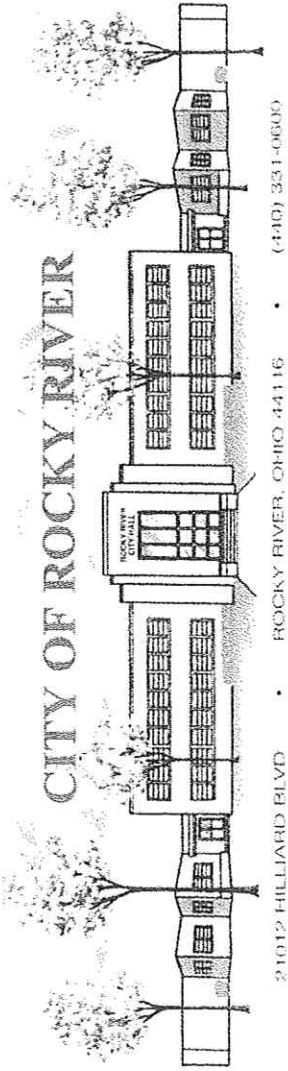

The City received two bids on March 13, 2023 for the CUY-006A / Beachcliff Blvd. PID 115897 Pedestrian Crossing Improvements.

1. RMH Concrete & Foundations	\$ 225,496.40	
2. Perk Company, Inc.	\$ 255,145.40	\$ 29,649.00
Engineer's Estimate	\$ 242,000.00	

RMH Concrete & Foundations has the required experience and equipment and has previously provided this type of work in several cities. Daniel Gerson with the City of Mayfield Heights, and Brian Ashurst with the City of Mentor gave favorable recommendations. RMH Concrete & Foundations is ODOT prequalified and has satisfactorily completed several ODOT projects.

RMH Concrete & Foundations has completed all required forms in the bid book and provided a copy of a search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database showing they are not listed in the database. A copy of the certified search is attached hereto. The SAM.gov exclusion database was searched and RMH was not listed in the exclusion database. A copy of the search is attached hereto.
