ORDINANCE NO. 34-23

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RMH CONCRETE & FOUNDATIONS, FOR THE SAFETY TOWN PROJECT AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$269,610.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the Safety Town Project; and

WHEREAS, one (1) bid was received on April 3, 2023, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer along with the Director of Public Safety Service have evaluated the bid and recommend the bid from RMH Concrete & Foundations, be accepted in the amount of Two Hundred Sixty Nine Thousand, Six Hundred Ten Dollars and 00/100 (\$269,610.00), as further described in the attached Exhibit "A".

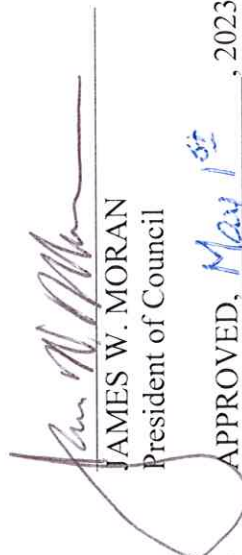
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with RMH Concrete & Foundations, 4433 Collins Road, Collins, Ohio 44826, for the Safety Town Project in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Sixty Nine Thousand, Six Hundred Ten Dollars and 00/100 (\$269,610.00), as further described in the attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the cost of the Safety Town Project shall be paid from the Capital Improvements Fund-Land Improvements account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

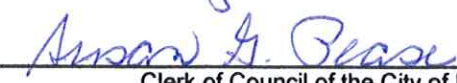
