ORDINANCE NO. 37-23

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CHAGRIN VALLEY PAVING, INC., FOR THE HILLIARD BOULEVARD RESURFACING PROJECT FROM GASSER BOULEVARD TO WOOSTER ROAD AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$442,347.20, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A".

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the Hilliard Boulevard Resurfacing Project from Gasser Boulevard to Wooster Road); and

WHEREAS, six (6) bids were received on April 3, 2023, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer along with the Director of Public Safety Service have evaluated the bids and recommend the lowest and best bid from Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc., be accepted in the amount of Four Hundred Forty Two Thousand Three Hundred Forty Seven Dollars and 20/100 (\$442,347.20), as further described in the attached Exhibit "A".

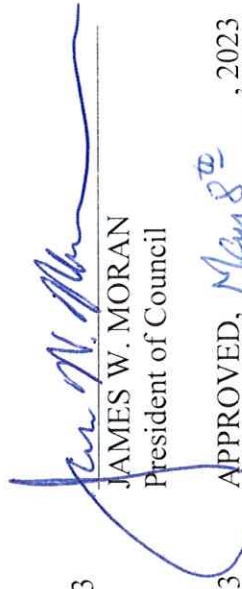
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc., 17290 Munn Road, Chagrin Falls, OH 44023 for the Hilliard Boulevard Resurfacing Project from Gasser Boulevard to Wooster Road, in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Forty Two Thousand Three Hundred Forty Seven Dollars and 20/100 (\$442,347.20), as further described in the attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the cost of the Hilliard Boulevard Resurfacing Project from Gasser Boulevard to Wooster Road shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund- Capital Improvement Roads account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

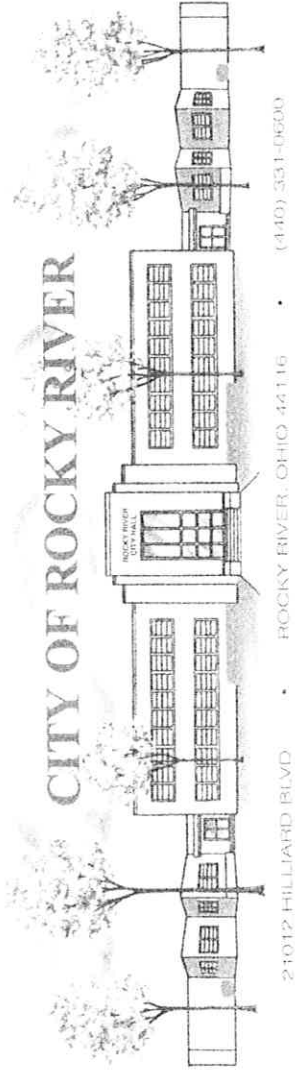

The City received six bids on April 3, 2023 for the Hilliard Boulevard (C.R. 69 Resurfacing).
