AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO UTILIZE THE SERVICES OF THE SMITHGROUP FOR ADDITIONAL ENGINEERING AND DESIGN REVIEW FOR THE BRADSTREET'S LANDING WATERFRONT IMPROVEMENTS PHASE II, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$25,000.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the SmithGroup has provided the City of Rocky River specialized engineering and design review services for the Bradstreet's Landing Pier and Waterfront Improvement projects; and

WHEREAS: the City needs to utilize the SmithGroup's engineering and design review services for Phase II of the Bradstreet's Landing Waterfront Improvement project, in an amount not to exceed Twenty Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$25,000.00), as further explained in Exhibit "A"; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Safety Service is hereby authorized to utilize the engineering and design review services from SmithGroup, 201 Depot Street, 2nd Floor, Ann Arbor, MI 48104, for the Bradstreet's Landing Waterfront Improvement Phase II project, in an amount not to exceed Twenty Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$25,000.00), as further explained in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That payment for said services shall be paid from and Capital Improvement Fund – Engineering Services account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that the service are necessary to ensure a successful construction season and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

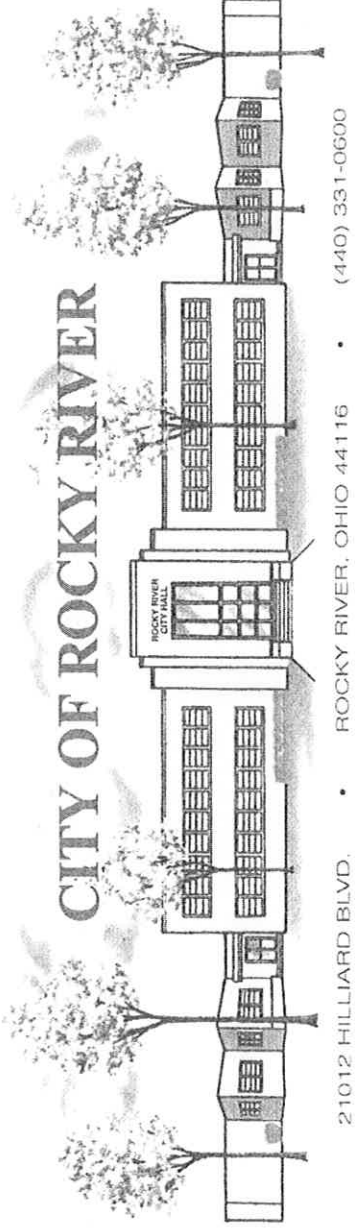

RE: SmithGroup – Additional Authorization for Engineering and Design Services

We are requesting authorization to expend up to \$25,000.00 with SmithGroup for Engineering and Design Services associated with Phase II of the Bradstreet's Landing Waterfront Improvement Project. This is not a request for additional appropriations.

SmithGroup is the Engineering and Design Services firm that has provided services for all previous stages of the Bradstreet's Landing Improvement project, including the 2018 Master Plan and Phase I, the renovation of the pier. Their continued services are necessary for Clarifications and Requests for Information (RFI's) from the contractor pertaining to the design of Phase II improvements as the construction commences. Due to the prolonged duration of Phase I of the improvement project, additional funding authorization is necessary for the completion of Phase II.

SmithGroup's experience with the Bradstreet's Landing Improvement Project and understanding of the design is essential to ensuring an efficient and cost effective completion of this phase of construction.
