ORDINANCE NO. 5-23

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO EXTEND A CONTRACT FOR ONE (1) YEAR FOR FULL SERVICE VENDING WITH METROPOLITAN VENDING COMPANY FOR THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER RECREATION DEPARTMENT, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety Service advertised for proposals in 2020 for a two (2) year full service vending agreement providing for food and beverage machines with the ability to renew on an annual basis, upon agreement of the parties; and

WHEREAS: pursuant to Ordinance No. 5-21 City Council adopted the acceptance of the proposal for full service vending from Metropolitan Vending Company, P.O. Box 43003, Cleveland, OH 44143, for a two (2) years, which proposal included an offer for the City to make annual renewals of this contract upon no increases in price; and

WHEREAS: City Council now determines that it is in the best interest of the City to extend this contract for an additional one (1) year period, as further described in the attached Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service are hereby authorized to extend the contract with Metropolitan Vending Company, P.O. Box 43003, Cleveland, OH 44143, for an additional one (1) year period, as further described in the attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That commissions received herein shall be credited to the Concession Vending Commissions Fund.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and to continue the services and amenities provided to the public by this vendor and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

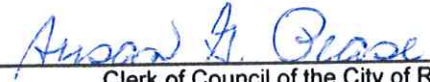
