AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH F. P. ALLEGA CONCRETE CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION FOR THE 2023 SIDEWALK PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,800.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the 2023 Sidewalk Program which will provide sidewalk repairs in areas where tree roots or utilities in the City right-of-way have caused damage to City sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were received on June 16, 2023, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service has evaluated the bids and recommends the lowest and best bid from F. P. Allega Concrete Construction Corporation, be accepted in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$250,800.00) as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with F. P. Allega Concrete Construction Corporation, 7725 Commerce Park Oval, Suite B, Independence, Ohio 44131, in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$250,800.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the 2023 Sidewalk Program, shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund-Capital Improvement Sidewalks.

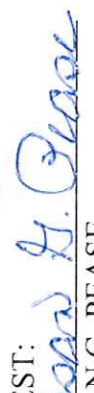
SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

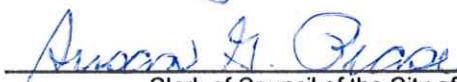

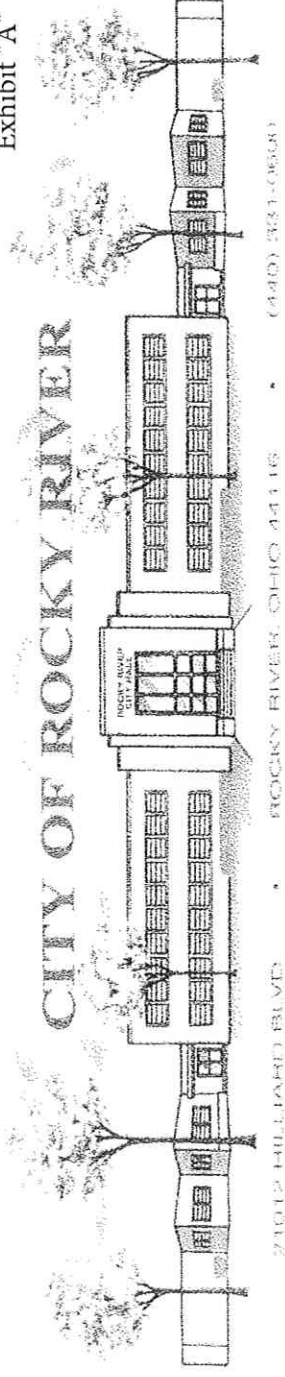

Mayor Bobst,

The City received two (2) bids on June 16, 2023 for the 2023 Sidewalk Repair Program.

<u>Contractor</u>	<u>Bid:</u>	<u>Difference from Low Bidder:</u>
1. F.P. Allega Concrete Construction Corp.	\$250,800.00*	
2. Mango Management Services	\$258,308.00	\$7,508.00
Engineer's Estimate:		\$255,000.00

*Bidder also submitted unit price of \$13/ft² of 4" sidewalk removal and replacement and \$14/ft² of 6" sidewalk removal and replacement for private property owners who enter into contract with contractor on or before September 30, 2023.

F.P. Allega Concrete Construction Corporation has the required experience and equipment and has provided this type of work in the Cities of Lakewood and Parma. Mark Papke of Lakewood and Erik Tollerup of Parma provided very favorable recommendations.

F.P. Allega Concrete Construction Corporation has completed all required forms in the bid book and provided a copy of the search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database showing they are not listed in the database.

I recommend that the contract in the amount of \$250,800.00 be awarded to: F.P. Allega Concrete Construction Corporation, 7725 Commerce Park Oval, Suite B, Independence, Ohio 44131, as being the lowest and best bid.
