AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH NORTHEAST OHIO TRENCHING SERVICES, INC., FOR THE ROCKY RIVER PARK OVERLOOK DECK IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$237,000.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN THE ATTACHED EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the Rocky River Park Overlook Deck; and

WHEREAS, one (1) bid was received on June 16, 2023, as further described in Exhibit "A" attached, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety Service; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the bid and recommends the bid from Northeast Ohio Trenching Services, Inc., be accepted in the amount of Two Hundred Thirty Seven Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$237,000.00) as further described in the attached Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Northeast Ohio Trenching Services, Inc., 17900 Miles Road, Warrensville Heights, Ohio 44128, in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Thirty Seven Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$237,000.00), as further described in the attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the Rocky River Park Overlook Deck, shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund–Rocky River Park Account.

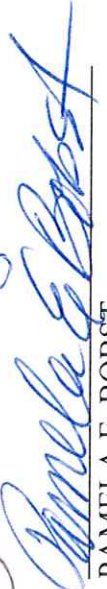
SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

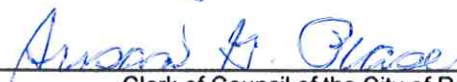

The City received one (1) bid on June 16, 2023 for the Rocky River Park Overlook Deck.

1. Northeast Ohio Trenching Services, Inc.	\$ 237,000.00
Engineer's Estimate	\$ 227,000.00

Northeast Ohio Trenching Services, Inc. (NEOTS) has the required experience and equipment to perform this work. NEOTS has satisfactorily completed the construction of a new pre-manufactured restroom and associated utility and site work at Bain Park in the City of Fairview Park. Mary Kay Costello, Director of Service and Economic Development provided a favorable recommendation. NEOTS also completed site development and paving work for the entry into Howe Road Park in the City of Tallmadge and Michael Rorar with the City of Tallmadge provided a favorable recommendation.

Northeast Ohio Trenching Services, Inc. has completed all required forms in the bid book and provided a copy of a search of the Auditor of State's Unresolved Findings Database showing they are not listed in the database. A copy of the certified search is attached hereto.
