AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY-SERVICE TO PURCHASE ONE (1) EMERGENCY MEDICAL AMBULANCE FROM PFUND SUPERIOR SALES FOR THE FIRE DIVISION AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$420,536.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River advertised for bids for the purchase of one (1) Emergency Medical Ambulance for the City of Rocky River Fire Division; and

WHEREAS: one (1) bid was received on July 21, 2023 for the Emergency Medical Ambulance, copy of which is on file in the office of the Director of Public Safety-Service;

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service has determined it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to accept the bid for the Emergency Medical Ambulance for the Fire Division from Pfund Superior Sales in the amount of Four Hundred Twenty Thousand Five Hundred Thirty Six Dollars and 00/100 (\$420,536.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Safety-Service Director of the City of Rocky River is hereby authorized to purchase one (1) Emergency Medical Ambulance from Pfund Superior Sales, 221 Chester Drive, Lower Burrell, PA 15068, at a total cost not to exceed Four Hundred Twenty Thousand Five Hundred Thirty Six Dollars and 00/100 (\$420,536.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That \$420,536.00 shall be paid from the Equipment Purchase Fund – EMS Vehicles and Large Equipment account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that it is necessary to update the Fire Division vehicle fleet and to facilitate the vehicle's manufacturing process, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of twothirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
