AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH FABRIZI TRUCKING & PAVING COMPANY, INC. FOR THE EMERGENCY REPAIR OF STREETS AND STORM AND SANITARY SEWERS WITHIN THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER AND THE WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$325,000.00 AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: as detailed in Ordinance 16-23 the City entered into a contract with Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Company for emergency repair of streets and storm and sanitary sewers for the City of Rocky River and the Waste Water Treatment Plant in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Seventy Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$175,000.00); and

WHEREAS: due to the significant increase in pricing for sewer repairs and infrastructure conditions that were undetectable, emergency sewer and street repairs have caused the need to supplement the agreement with Fabrizi Trucking and Paving for 2023 in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$325,000.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Director of Public Safety Service are hereby authorized to supplement the agreement with Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Company, Inc., 20389 First Avenue, Middleburg Hts., OH, 44130, for the emergency repair of streets and storm and sanitary sewers for 2023 at a total net cost not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$500,000.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That funds for the payment of said services shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund-Emergency Sewer Repair Account and the WWTP Utility Fund.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by

**Emergency Sewer Contract Authorization Amendment** 

Mayor Bobst,

On March 27, 2023, City Council authorized the administration to enter a contract with Fabrizi Trucking and Paving, Inc. for emergency sewer repairs to be implemented throughout the City and at the Wastewater Treatment Plant with Ordinance 16-23. That contract was not to exceed \$175,000.00. Per the terms of the new contract, the cost of repairs increased significantly compared to the prior rates from the 2011 bid. To date in 2023, the City has used Fabrizi Trucking and Paving, Inc. for five (5) emergency sewer repairs deemed immediate need, and/or outside the capacity of our Sewer Maintenance Division, including:

- \$7,330.50 (Elmwood/Kenwood)
- \$19,468.00 (Wooster Rd)
- \$67,290.00 (Service Garage Sanitary Sewer)
- \$64,950.00 (Hilliard/Westway)
- \$244,049.00 (Center Ridge Rd)

Total: \$403,087.50

I request authorization for an additional \$325,000.00 to increase the authorization amount with Fabrizi Trucking and Paving, Inc. for emergency sewer repair to \$500,000. The added funds would include a supplemental appropriations request of \$100,000 with the remaining funds previously appropriated to the Capital Improvement Fund.
