AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH G & B ELECTRIC COMPANY, FOR THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT FIRE ALARM INSTALLATION AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$73,300.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River requested proposals for the Service Department Fire Alarm Installation; and

WHEREAS, four (4) proposals were received on September 8, 2023, copies of which are on file in the office of the Safety Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the Facilities Director has evaluated the proposals and recommends the lowest and best bid from G & B Electric Company, for the Service Department Fire Alarm Installation be accepted in the amount of Seventy Three Thousand Three Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$73,300.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with G & B Electric Company, 10343 Brecksville Road, Brecksville, Ohio 44141, for the Service Department Fire Alarm Installation in the amount of Seventy Three Thousand Three Hundred Dollars and 00/100 (\$73,300.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That the cost of the Service Department Fire Alarm Installation shall be paid from Capital Improvement Fund-Building account.

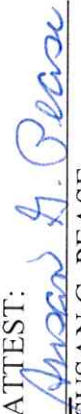
SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is necessary to proceed immediately so that these improvements begin within the construction season and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

RE: Service Building fire alarm installation

After completing a Request for Proposals for the Service building fire alarm installation, we received four (4) proposals. The lowest proposal was Silco Fire and Security but included several exceptions. Therefore, G & B Electric was the Lowest and Best proposal, costing **\$73,300.00**.

This proposal is a complete turnkey design and installation fire life safety system following National Fire Protection Act (NFPA) 72 standards. This system will include the entire garage area, transfer station building and chemical storage building.
