ORDINANCE NO. 9-23

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY-SERVICE TO PURCHASE ONE (1) FORD EXPLORER FROM STATEWIDE FORD LINCOLN/STATEWIDE EMERGENCY PRODUCTS FOR THE FIRE DIVISION AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$55,878.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service of the City of Rocky River sourced fully outfitted emergency response vehicles for the purchase of one (1) Ford Explorer for the Chief of the Fire Division; and

WHEREAS: the Director of Public Safety-Service has determined it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to accept the pricing for one (1) Ford Explorer for the Fire Division from Statewide Ford Lincoln/Statewide Emergency Products in the amount of Fifty Five Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy Eight Dollars and 00/100 (\$55,878.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Safety-Service is hereby authorized to purchase one (1) Ford Explorer for the Fire Division from Statewide Ford Lincoln/Statewide Emergency Products, 1114 West Main Street, Van Wert, Ohio 45891, in the amount of Fifty Five Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy Eight Dollars and 00/100 (\$55,878.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That \$55,878.00 shall be paid from the Equipment Purchase Fund – Fire Vehicles and Large Equipment account.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and for the further reason that it is necessary to update the Fire Division vehicle fleet and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
