AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICE TO PURCHASE PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT FOR MARTIN PARK FROM SNIDER RECREATION INC. AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$125,000.00, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A"

WHEREAS: the Director of Recreation requested proposals for pricing for the purchase of new Playground Equipment for Martin Park; and

WHEREAS: three (3) proposals were vetted by the Parks and Recreation Commission, Parks and Recreation Foundation as well as the Recreation Department staff, copies of which are on file in the office of the Director of Recreation; and

WHEREAS: the Director of Recreation along with the Director of Public Safety Service have determined it to be in the best interest of the City of Rocky River to select the lowest and best bid for the Playground Equipment for Martin Park from Snider Recreation, 10139 Royalton Road #K, North Royalton, Ohio, 44133, at a total cost not to exceed One Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$125,000.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKY RIVER, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Safety Service of the City of Rocky River be and is hereby authorized to purchase Playground Equipment for Martin Park from Snider Recreation, 10139 Royalton Road #K, North Royalton, Ohio, 44133, at a cost not to exceed One Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$125,000.00), as further described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That \$125,000.00 for the cost of said playground equipment shall be paid from the Capital Improvement Fund - Martin Park account.

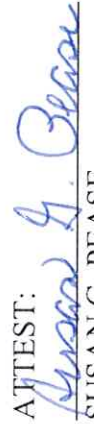

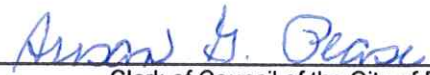

MEMORANDUM

RE: Martin Park Playground

Upon completing a thorough review of three vendor proposals related to the replacement of the Martin Park Playground, I would recommend the project be awarded to Snider Recreation at the competitive price of \$125,000.00. This structure would be replacing the current playground that was installed approximately 20 years ago.

Removal of the current structure and excavation of space will completed by the City. Installation of new equipment and wood fibar to be completed by Snider with an average lead time of between eight and ten weeks for standard items. The structure will meet all ADA requirements and be built with approximately 35% recycled product. The vendor has offered that weather pending, the equipment may be installed over the winter months but will be completed by/before spring 2024.

The attached Burke Product design has been shared with the Parks & Recreation Commission, Parks & Recreation Foundation as well as the Recreation Department Staff. Additionally, after a search of Finding for Recovery with the Ohio Auditor of State, the vendor record came back negative.

Snider has been selected because of the overall play-value that includes various elements that allow for children 2-12 years of age to participate as well as several unique pieces that make the structure(s) slightly more diverse.

For reference, the vendors considered include:
